7.1 Superintendent's Report

Superintendent Sarah Dildine gave the Board the current enrollment - 1162 as of last Friday, as well as information for the holiday events that have already been planned. She advised the Board that the School Safety Grant has been released, but the grant application has not been yet. As soon as it is, the District will apply. HSISD is qualified for \$200,000; TEA is surveying districts regarding cost estimates for compliance with proposed safety standards. Junior High OAP won first place in district competition, believed to be the first ever for

junior high school. As part of the proposed safety standards for HSISD, exterior door numbering is in progress. Interior locks have been installed on classroom doors and a new secure door has been installed at the administration building.

7.2 Business Manager's Report

Business Manger Jalyn Setser advised the board that the District now has a total of twelve Certificates of Deposit at the Texas Heritage National Bank in Daingerfield, Texas. They each mature monthly, so that funds will be readily available if needed.
