Mindy Robertson with ETCADA presented Vaping. She showed how we went from Great American Smoke Out Nov. 18th used to be to help quite cigarettes and dipping to using devices where nicotine, marijuana, alcohol, and other drugs are being accessed through “Vaping.” See slides attached.

Angela Thompson discussed the ACE, Blast, or After School Programs as follows:

Texas Afterschool Centers on Education.

Texas ACE creates community learning centers that provide opportunities during non-school hours, particularly for students who attend high-poverty and low-performing schools and their families. ACE is designed to improve student performance on state assessments, grades, school day attendance, and discipline referrals. The positive effects include increasing the following;

STAAR–Mathematics and STAAR–Reading

Fewer disciplinary incidents.

Increased school day attendance

Increased likelihood of grade promotion overall

Currently Daingerfield Junior High is required to have 60 students but is currently serving 119 students and has 27 adult participates. South campus is required to have 62 students and is currently serving 87 students and has 30 adult participates. Family Engagement assist adult family members and students in meeting their physical and emotional needs. A survey and needs assessments is given to all adult family members to complete to address concerns and needs. The survey covers three categories, Family Immediate Needs Adult Enrichment and Student Academics. The Interest Surveys covers family interest, fun and best meeting days and times. The ACE program serves children from Pre-K -12th grade.

Natalie Ruan also described what schools she coordinates with. She works through Reg 8 ESC.
