

Skill Set #5: Together is Better (pages 49-52) 400 points

Task #1 Leadership Stories of each skill set (#1-#7): 15 points for each Skill Set story read. Mr. Miller will be reading these stories on Fridays.

Task #2 Picture Matching: Cut out a popular cartoon dividing into equal pieces based on the number per team and have the group members reproduce the images of the piece they were given. The students then place pieces together to replicate original cartoon accurately. 50 points (K-5th)

Task #3 Sneak Peak: Divide students into groups. Create a structure using building blocks without students seeing it. Allow one student to see structure for 10 seconds and then comeback to their group and explain the structure to group so that they can recreate the structure. 50 points (K-5th)

Task #4 Community Team: Become a member of a school or community group. (ex. Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, Sports team, Dance, etc.) 50 points (K-5th)

Task #5 Go Game: Children stand in a circle, pick volunteer to start the game. Player 1 begins by making direct eye contact with another student (#2) and tells him "GO" who then takes #1's place and #1 take #2's place. The game is over after every one has changed spots. 50 points (K-5th)

Task #6 Group Juggle Game: divide into groups of 5 and make a circle. Start out with 2 balls asking them to juggle the balls in a specific order and slowly add balls to be juggled between group members. The group that juggles the balls the longest with out dropping them wins. 50 points (K-5th)

Task#7 Don't wake the Dragon Game: Students pretend they are in a village captured by a Dragon. The children can only escape if they can arrange themselves in order of their height without speaking. When the students think they are right they Yell BOO! If they are right they win, if they are wrong the dragon wins. 50 points (K-5th)

Task #8 Coin Logo: Put different coins in a bag and ask each student to pick a coin. Divide the students into groups of 3 with the students using their coins as inspiration for their own coin. Students have 20 minutes to design and then explain what the Logo stands for. 50 points (K-5th)

Task #9 Hula Hoop: Children form big circle place the hula hoop on one student's arm and the group holds hands and have to figure out how to get the hula hoop all the way around the circle. (K-5th)
