5th 6 Weeks Report Cards

6th 6 Weeks Progress Reports

The HSISD Board of Trustees waived the progress report requirement in Policy EIA (Local) at our April 13th Board Meeting.

Therefore, we do not plan to issue progress reports for the 6th 6 weeks. We will issue final grades/report cards for the 6th 6 weeks & semester after the last day of the current academic year which is May 21, 2020.

Class Rank/GPA for High School Students

The HSISD Board of Trustees passed a resolution modifying Policy EIC (Local) as it relates to calculating Class Rank & GPA for Hughes Springs High School students for the 2019-2020 school year. We are working on a FAQ document that specifically addresses questions that parents/students will have regarding class rank & GPA. Our plan is to post that document later this week. We will also send it out via email to all HSHS students and via email to parents thru our Skyward Family Access system.

3:00 – 5:00 = Junior High & High School Campuses

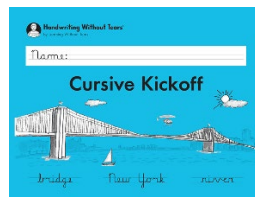
Monday, April 20
