We have a grant that will service patients at Titus Regional Medical Center, including those in Morris County. It is called Breast and Cervical Cancer Screening Services, and it covers the entire cost of approved Breast and Cervical cancer screening procedures for uninsured and underinsured patients. This includes screening mammograms. Grant eligibility guidelines include:

- Gross family income at or below 200% of the adopted Federal Poverty Level (FPL)
- Applicant is a Texas Resident
- Are a woman aged 18 or over
- Do not have health insurance or are underinsured.
