

Hughes Springs Independent School District Cafeteria Charging Policy



Effective on Monday, August 27, 2012

What is the charging limit?

- \$10 is the limit allowed for charges per family account.

What happens when an account reaches the charging limit?

- An alternate meal is offered at no charge after the \$10 limit.
- Elementary alternate meal is peanut butter and jelly Sandwich and milk.
- Junior High and High School alternate meal consists of non starchy vegetables, bread and milk.

Can my child still purchase “extras” if we owe money?

- No, a student is not allowed to purchase any extras if they owe money. Examples of Extras: tea, ice cream, extra meat, etc.

How often does the school send out account notices?

- An automated phone call is made on Monday nights to the parent’s home phone number when the \$10 limit is reached.
- Junior High and High School students must sign their name confirming they are charging a meal & they can check their balance daily, by simply asking the cashier.
- Parents can also view their cafeteria account online through Skyward Family Access. Call your child’s campus for your username/password.
