

# Baseball / Softball Event Guidelines

## Spectators, Audiences & Fans

Spectators, audience members and fans are subject to current state, local and HSISD guidelines regarding screenings & masks.

**As it currently stands, everyone over the age of 10 will be required to wear a mask per the Governor Abbott's executive order.**

Exceptions to wearing of face covering or face shields include:

- Any person with a medical condition or disability that prevents wearing a face covering.
- While a person is consuming food / drink
- While the person is in a swimming pool, lake, or similar body of water.
- When a congregating group of persons maintains at least 6 feet of social distancing.
- Any other reason or circumstance indicated under Executive Order GA-29

## Concession Stands

Concession stands will be open at the games. Please follow all directives and signage located at the concession stands. Please maintain 6 feet of social distancing and respect other people's personal space.

## Capacity

We can have a maximum of 50% capacity in our venues.

We will have every other row marked off in venues. **Please do not sit on the rows/seats that are marked off.**

Spectators are welcome to set along the fences of both stadiums and on the outfield hill at the baseball stadium.

Please allow for 6 feet of social distancing between your family group and the next family group on the same row.

**Please respect other people's personal space.**

## Tickets

We will not be charging fans to enter the baseball or softball stadiums this year.

Keep in mind other districts may have different requirements in place for entrance into their stadiums and venues. **As we are made aware of these requirements, we will notify parents via social media.**

## Cooperation & Teamwork

Everyone (staff, students, parents & fans) agree we **absolutely** want our students to be able to participate in extracurricular activities!

To give our students that experience, we are going to have to follow the guidelines that have been put in place by the UIL, whether we agree with them or not!

All fans, audience members and spectators need to follow any directives given to them by HSISD staff members. Failure to do so could result in your ejection from the stadium, gym, or venue.

In Texas, we are fortunate to be competing in sports when so many states across the country are not. For students to have the opportunity to continue to compete in UIL activities this school year, we all must remain diligent in following these guidelines.

Schools not following these guidelines are subject to sanctions by the local UIL District Executive Committee and/or UIL State Executive Committee. Sanctions can include suspension of contests or discontinuation of public access to games!
