

Hughes Springs Jr. High Campus Health Guidelines 2020-2021



Mask Expectations

Masks are currently required and are part of the dress code.

Students must wear a mask upon entering the school, during passing periods, and in class.

There are certain activities in some classes, (i.e. band, P.E., athletics, etc.) where the teacher will allow students to remove their masks for specific purposes, but removal of the mask will only be allowed at the teacher's direction.

Before-School Procedures

Students will not be allowed into the building prior to 7:25.

All students will be assigned a homeroom. On alternating weeks, one class will go to the gym while the others remain in their homeroom until the 7:50 bell.

Breakfast will be served from 7:30-7:45. Students choosing to eat breakfast will do so in their homeroom or gym.

Passing Periods Between Classes

To ensure proper social distancing, passing periods between classes will be staggered.

At the bell to release from each class, 7th grade students will move to their next period. Three minutes later, 6th grade students will move followed by 8th grade students.

Water Bottles

All campus water fountains will be converted to water-bottle fillers.

Your student is encouraged to bring their own water bottle each day to ensure they can stay hydrated. Any container with a screw on lid may be used.

Students will not be allowed to share water bottles.

Lunches

Outside food will not be accepted in the office nor may be dropped off to students at the cafeteria. Students choosing to bring their lunch must do so when they come to school.

If a student forgets to bring his/her lunch, a full meal will be provided to them in the cafeteria and charged to their lunch account. Visitors will not be allowed in the cafeteria during lunch.

Hygiene and Disinfecting

Encourage your student to thoroughly wash his/her hands multiple times per day while at school.

Students will be required to use hand sanitizer upon entering or leaving every classroom.

In addition, at the end of each class, students will be asked to disinfect their work area with disinfecting wipes and/or spray provided by the teacher.

Social Distancing

Where possible (i.e. during passing periods, lunch, Flex, etc.) students will be expected to maintain 6 feet of space between them.

Students will be constantly reminded to maintain a safe distance from one another where feasible, and it is important that this message is reiterated at home.
